

The Back Cove 32



Over the 14 year history of the Back Cove range, more than 700 hulls have been built and shipped worldwide. Back Cove's Design Team has looked to a set of simple tenets to create a range of boats that today spans 30 to 41 feet. The Back Cove 32 is an all-new design that follows the same basic idea that a Back Cove will have a single diesel engine for great performance and fuel efficiency, and an exterior that is easily cared for at the end of a cruise. A bow thruster enhances low speed maneuverability, and her centerline engine has abundant space around it's perimeter, enabling many owners to do their own maintenance and keep operating costs low.

Comfortable, soft-riding hulls with downward turning chines are dry, while side decks are always wide and large diameter handrails are always within reach. There is nothing more practical and functional than a Back Cove yacht.



The lines of the Back Cove 32 are indisputably "Downeast." Her elegant shear line and low hull profile harken to the traditional Maine work boats. Large opening windows in her pilot house provide unequalled sight lines for the Captain and crew.

The Back Cove 32 cockpit is a study in ergonomics with luxurious seating for you and all of your guests. Optional inlaid tables add a touch of elegance to this inviting space.





The cockpit sole of the Back Cove 32 is a single level from the transom gate to the companionway. This feature increases sociability with all of your crew and guests gathered on one level. To port, a Ushaped settee which can convert to a dinette with a second inlaid table and base. The forward seatback slides easily from settee to mates seat location so that the mate always has a clear and unobstructed view when underway.



Her helm pod is sized to suit today's modern chart plotters. Also found here are the bow thruster control, optional stern thruster controller and trim tab controls. A raised helm seat pedestal assures excellent site lines. An acrylic sliding companionway door with screen encloses the accommodations below deck.



To starboard is the yacht's galley which offers cooktop, large stainless steel sink and stainless steel refrigerator. Optionally a propane cooktop, an icemaker and a freezer can be fitted if chosen. A large amount of storage is found in the beautifully crafted galley cabinets.



Below deck your private oasis awaits with a queen-sized pedestal berth. Ample storage is provided on the outboard shelves and lockers and in the large drawers fitted below the berth. Lockers port and starboard contain additional drawers and hanging space.

Her head unit is split with the toilet and wash basin to port and a large shower stall to starboard.
